"You then, my son, **be strong** in the **grace** that is in Christ Jesus." (v. 1)





"12 I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength, that he considered me trustworthy, appointing me to his service. 13 Even though I was once a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent man, I was shown mercy because I acted in ignorance and unbelief. 14 The grace of our Lord was poured out on me abundantly, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. ¹⁵ Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners—of whom I am the worst." (1 Tim. 1:12-15)





Humility

Gratitude

"Thank you, God, for saving me from sin, death and hell through your Son Jesus! I am forever grateful to you!"





Courage

"God loves me so much to a point He gave His One and Only Son Jesus to die on the cross to pay the penalty of my sin. If God loves me this much, then what will He not do for me? If God is for me, who can be against me!"
