

- 80 house churches


## Why this Survey?

## **Top Reasons For Wanting To Quit Shepherding:**

#### Feeling Inadequate

I think about it sometimes. I'm not a natural leader and not confident at times, so I get dejected from time to time.

Yes. Things get hard and it feels like a grind when you see no fruit and just frustration for years.

#### Biting the Shepherd

Whenever a HC member told me all the things I was doing wrong I wanted to quit. I said to myself if I am doing so many things wrong then why am I even a shepherd.

#### Feeling Overwhelmed

Yes. I was overwhelmed as a single shepherd...being the youngest one out of the house church, total # of house church members at that time was about 15 adults and 7 infants/children. At the same time I was working a 7-day on 7-day off work schedule with 12 hour night shifts and day shifts.

There have been times when my wife and I have heated arguments and sometimes those arguments can lead to juvenile talks of quitting shepherding,

#### Drama Sheep

Yes - many times. When we have difficult members who brings their drama to HC.

Seeing VIPs Saved We have seen how HC saves lives and families when they grow in Christ. That is why we keep going.



"We love our house church and our village. I cannot stress enough how close we have become to our house church members and village. We are family, and in many case, closer than blood family. Our children have been friends since birth and have known only house church as life. The bond of Christ - being rooted and built up in Christ - makes this a stronger communal bond than anything the world can offer. We continue to see God working in not just our lives and our house church members' lives but other house church members' lives and are encouraged by that. We have seen victory through HC. And we know HC works to make disciples of Christ because we are living examples, and we learned (and are continuing to learn) from the examples set by our previous shepherds."

First and foremost, PE is diligent about everything that he does, including his prayer time. Every workday, starting from very early in the morning, he is on his knees for 3 hours praying for our church and us individually. That is beyond comforting and encouraging. It's like he's recharging his and our church's power supply each morning through that prayer time. And because of all of that time he spends alone with God, I know he hears very clearly from Him, and because I know PE is obedient to God and sticks with what is in the Bible, I can feel confident that all of PE's decisions are Spirit-led and Scripture-tested.

In addition to his weekly sermons which serve to guide and encourage our church, Pastor Eric's modeling has been a huge encouragement. I see Pastor Eric's life as the fruit of living with God, and it encourages me to try my best to walk with God. Especially as a young person, it's hard to see life past the next few years; seeing Pastor Eric model what a mature Christian looks like (full of love, fulfillment, gratitude, peace, energy, joy, etc.) is greatly encouraging. Pastor Eric leads by example, his solid and unwavering character and commitment, none prays, works, gives more than him. Even financially, by percentage, he probably gives more than many of us. His consistency in following the word of God, no matter what, has truly been an example of spiritual leader to me. One way he could be more of a blessing would be to connect with people emotionally.

He always has our back as shepherds. I heard stories of members going to PE to complain about their shepherds and he almost always supports the shepherds side. And even on Sunday sermons he will blatantly tell everyone to thank their shepherds; "you think it's easy being a shepherd? You think it's easy taking care of people like you? Why don't you volunteer to be a shep yourself and see how difficult it is navigating the lives of 12 people every week". Haha. He always thanks us too, whether it's on the podium on during the village meetings he visits.
